Where is your team on the Digital Readiness journey?


- Many employees no longer have access to their files, lack clarity regarding virtual meeting protocols, or simply do not have ample or comfortable space in their homes to perform at their highest capacities.
- As well, clients' access to products and services may have been all online with end-to-end digital processes that are no longer easily accessible and lack digital governance to ensure compliance.
- Although many of these issues have been temporarily addressed in light of the pandemic, the reality is that the workforce is going to continue to digitalize at an increasingly fast pace.
- This means that right now there is an opportunity to take a look at what is and is not working, and to engage the workforce of the future with all of the required knowledge and tools to excel in the age of automation.
- Whether your team already has clear challenges or you are actively seeking out areas of improvement, a Digital Readiness Assessment will help. We will work with you to understand your people, process, and technology to give you a picture of where you are and how we can work together to develop and enhance your digital practices.

What is a Digital Readiness assessment?

- A digital readiness assessment is an evaluation of an organization's readiness to undertake digital transformation.
- A digital transformation framework is custom built for an organization and serves to evaluate opportunities, guide planning, and align digital strategies to a business' goals.
- A digital readiness assessment differs from an IT assessment in that an IT assessment focuses on pipes and plumbing identifying, providing and maintaining the technological infrastructure and solutions.
- The two strategies can be combined or developed separately.







THE ASSESSMENT

Surveys

To prepare for a digital transformation, it is necessary to gain an understanding of the environment that currently exists in terms of people, process and technology.

This is achieved through a survey whereby the results are compiled into a report that will help direct future efforts to close gaps and prepare the department for the digital transformation ahead.

The assessment takes a phased approach as follows:

Environment Scan

 Collect details of what has been done to date and obtain all relevant documents

Creation of Digital Framework from Policies

- Framework produced based on your policies and strategic direction that outlines both the current and intended state of Digital Readiness
- For example, our work with the GoC used the policies as described by the Treasury Board to conduct a framework
- Survey created based on this framework with a set of 10-15 questions on Digital Readiness

Survey and Consultations

 Time taken to understand your organization's needs so we can best describe your future state

Report

 Detailed report created based on the on-going conversations and survey results describing the as-is state of Digital Readiness, core issues, and any areas of improvement

 Interview invitations include an agenda outlining the content to be discussed to allow for those on your team to review the materials prior to discussions

Interviews

- Work collaboratively as we familiarize ourselves with your business to engage the relevant stakeholders in your organization in meaningful conversations and subsequent interviews
- Provide an interview guide with questions that align with the framework we have created
- Interviews may be conducted virtually or inperson depending on your organization's preferences - we have found that both methods lead to equally sucessful conversations
- Previously interviewed a variety of groups in this process, from scientists about which electronic microscopes they use, to security personnel about their digital locks, to discussing file security for those who work from home

Analysis

- Data analysis performed using Alteryx based on the survey results mapped back to the framework
- Visual representation typically also performed using Tableau

Workshop


- Presentation and discussion of survey results and interview findings
- Validation of consensus items
- Feedback provided to relevant branches or key groups including specific opportunities and challenges if necessary
- Recommendations provided at various organizational levels

Findings Report

- Report created describing the as-is state distributed to a designated contact point to deliver to the organization's leadership team
- Report delivered in the format that works best for your organization, including ppt, pdf, or even a secure document
